## *1. Crime and Patrol Summary*

*See attachments. The department responded to 1,153 requests for service during the month of September. Community Service responded to 131 requests for service.*

*The patrol division had another busy month handling calls for service. School zones are being patrolled during the drop off and pick up times to provide a safe environment for the children.*

*This month was busy for warrant arrests. These warrants were mainly for failure to comply with court orders or failure to appear. Several of these arrestees were also in possession of a controlled substance and were charged accordingly.*

*The bank robbery was highlighted in the Investigation report for this month, but just to let you know that the new camera system for city hall was able to capture the "getaway" vehicle. With this video we were able to identify the make of the vehicle and direction of travel.*

### *4. Investigations – Detective Sergeant Marvin Cameron*

*Investigations continue to be very busy. Detectives continue to Follow-up on previous reported sex crimes, domestic violence crimes as well as new reported felony crimes.*

*Sergeant Cameron transferred to the Detective Sergeant's position September 3, 2019.*

*On September 17, 2019 at approximately 10:07 hours a male party, Rudy Anthony Cardenas with a Date of Birth of 09-04-1984, walked into the Bank of Colorado located at 250 W. Victory Way. Cardenas demanded the teller's cash. The teller complied with Cardenas' request. Cardenas then fled the scene. This was the first bank robbery in Craig in recent history.*

*Craig Police Officers arrived within a minute or two and secured the scene and initiated the investigation. Detectives Norm Rimmer and Michael Cochran arrived and assumed control of the investigation. Working together, Detective Rimmer was able to identify Cardenas as the bank robber and identify a getaway vehicle.*

*A week later, September 24, 2019, Cardenas walked into a second Bank of Colorado in Rifle Colorado and committed a second bank robbery. Detective Rimmer quickly passed our information to Rifle Police and they determined that Cardenas had in fact robbed their bank.*

*The Craig Police Department, working with the 14<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office, the Rifle Police Department, the West Jordan Utah Police Department, the Grand Junction Police Department, The Colorado Information Analysis Center and the FBI were able to arrest Cardenas on September 27, 2019 in the Denver metro area.*

*I'm very proud of the job all officers did during this investigation. Detective Rimmer put in extensive hours completing reports, search warrants, an arrest warrant, and managing and coordinating these investigations with all of the other law enforcement agencies involved. Great job everyone!*

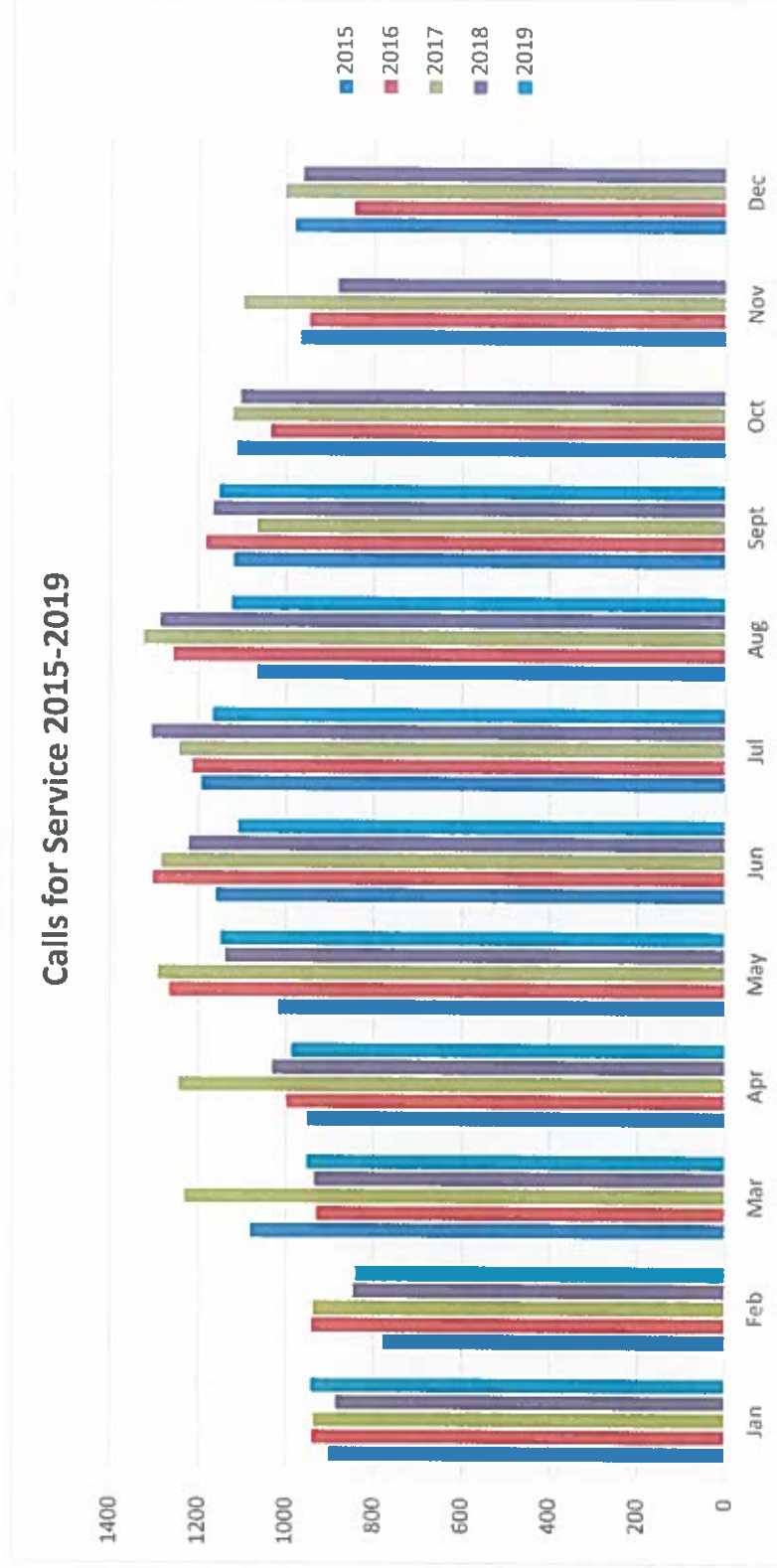
