SUBJECT: *Progress Report – August 2017*

1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,324 requests for service during the month of August. Community Service responded to 152 requests for service.

School is back in session. We are providing extra patrols in the school zones to make it as safe as we can for the students and motoring public. This month officers handled ten drug related calls for service. Almost all of the calls were for Schedule I and two possession incidents. The offenders in these cases were arrested and taken to jail for the violations.

Compared to previous months, we had an increase in arrests for restraining order violations. This month officers handled 15 cases that resulted in someone being arrested for violating a condition of the restraining order. Most of the arrests were for the consumption of alcohol or contact with a protective person from the restraining order.

2. *Community Service*

CSOs Josh Wright and Jill Nelson handled the following calls during the month of August.

Officer Fritz attended DARE training on the new electronic workbooks and DARE Mobile App this summer, at his own expense. He feels this addition to the program will be very beneficial to the students not only in the classroom, but in the long term.

- *Assisted staff with a Spanish-only speaking student who had been dropped off unregistered. Corporal Gonzales assisted me in going to the home and finding a parent.*
- *Student did not get off the bus at home, he had gotten on the wrong bus but made a good choice in where to get off and walked the short distance home.*

MCHS Activities

- *Met with incoming Principal Kyle York to discuss philosophy and SRO duties/responsibilities.*
- *Attended student re-entry meetings.*
- *Attended a joint meeting with MCSD, 14th DA and CPD discussing a joint press release on an arrested teacher.*
- *Attended MCHS Staff meeting and discussed ALICE protocol and general philosophy of the SRO program.*
- *Attended freshman orientation day, to include speaking at the parent meeting.*
- *Spoke to a freshman student about receiving letters from an inmate at the jail. Became a possible Luring/Enticement Investigation.*
- *Assisted patrol officers multiple times on gathering information on students.*
- *First day of school assembly, attended and spoke. A lot of changes this year with new leadership.*
- *Reckless driving complaint, 911 call of students "racing" at Kmart. Assisted patrol, total of 8 MCHS students in two vehicles involved.*
- *Planning meeting with student for his return to MCHS from Alternative School Placement*

- Spoke to multiple students about possible military service after graduation. More than normal already this year.
- Attended IEP meetings.
- Spoke to multiple students about tobacco use.
- Spoke to multiple students about foul language, respect, and expectations going into adulthood.

October 4th, we will test to fill the two positions.

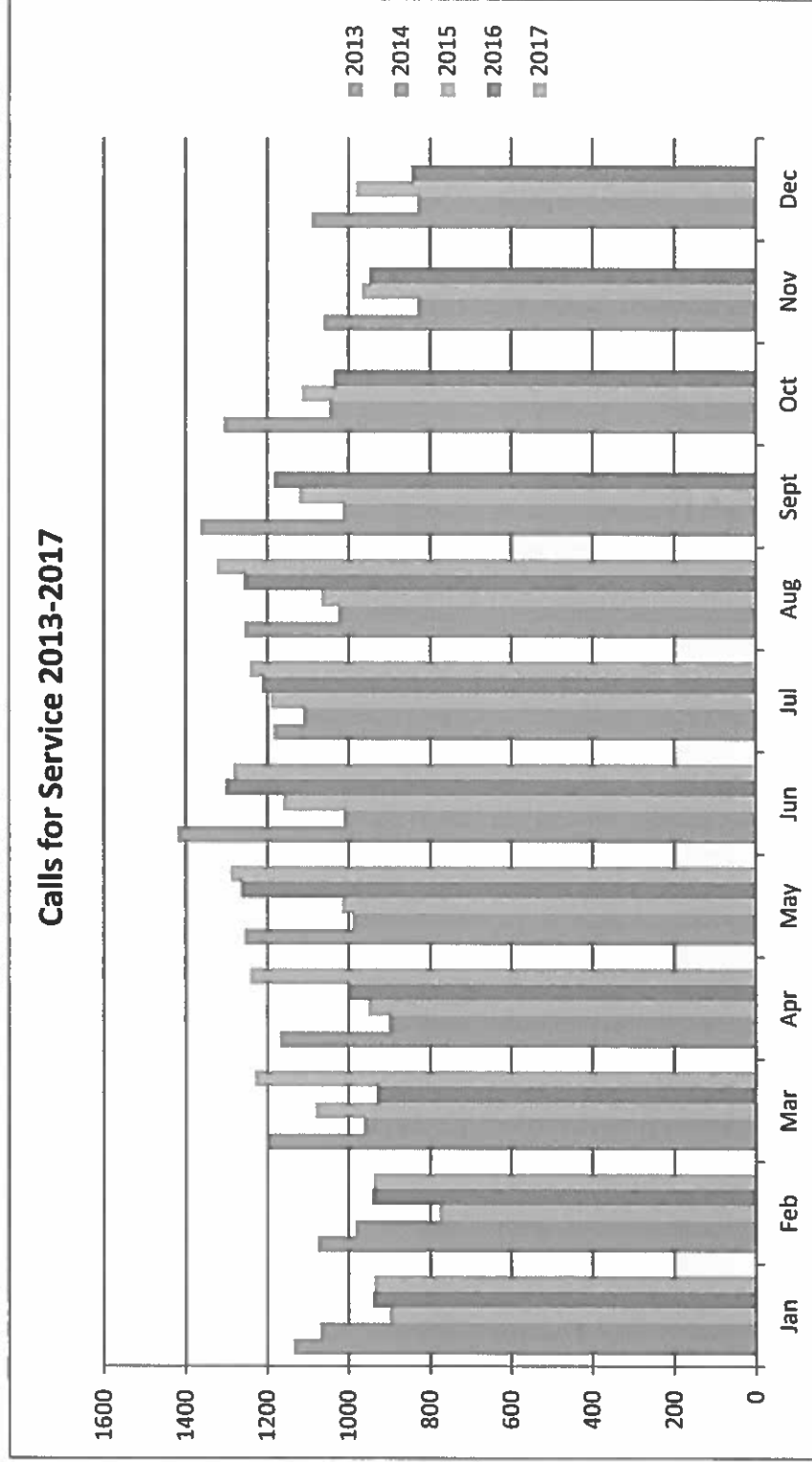
